



## 2024 – SCHOOL FEES

Omatas Learning Centre is a Cottage School designed to remediate your child back into a more typical school environment.

Our process takes from two years with the full cooperation of all parties involved in the child's process. Upon enrolment, you will receive our welcome pack which outlines many of the areas we will be working on and how you can support your child.

We do not include individual therapies but do assist you in finding suitable interventions if the need arises. Our consulting therapists are more than happy to work in our school environment and will work with us to supplement our programme.

From time to time, we may include or exclude any particular programme depending on needs, requirements and the constraints of the timetable. You are required to pay a once-off non-refundable registration fee on enrolment which supports the programmes made available to you as parents.

In terms of the school finance policy, fees are payable in advance by the last day of the previous month. School fees may be paid in a single payment or in 4, 10, 11 or 12 monthly instalments. Acceptance and enrolment is at the full discretion of Omatas.

A trial period is required along with any prior reports and assessments before a decision can be made. It is your responsibility to disclose all relevant information pertaining to your child so that we can structure a suitable intervention.

- Meet the principal and school tour
- 5 day trial
- Meeting to discuss enrolment
- Complete enrolment forms
- Pay Registration Fee
- Start at Omatas
- Receive parent support programme
- Complete family support assessment and feedback
- Begin the journey
